

# THE MURRAY BRIDGE GLIDING CLUB INC

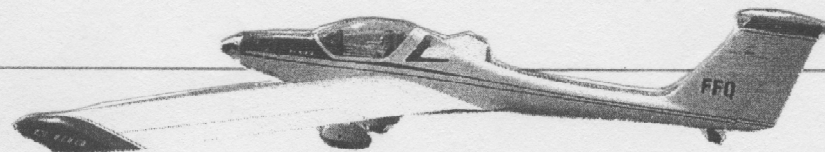
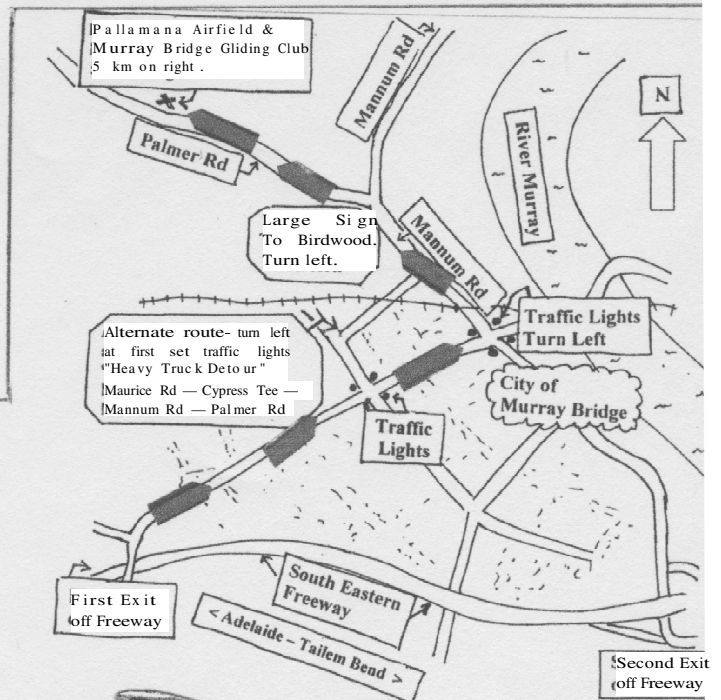

The Murray Bridge Gliding Club is situated at Pallamana Airfield, a few kilometres north-west of Murray Bridge.

We are a small club and fly on weekends by arrangement.

Arrangements to fly with us as a passenger or potential member can be made by contacting Lindsay Tilley on 08 7220 7890

Take the Murray Bridge exit off the freeway. Turn left at the second set of traffic lights, located in the city centre, onto Mannum Rd. Several kilometres on, turn left onto the Palmer Rd. towards Birdwood. The airfield is several kilometres along on the right.



The aircraft used for training and general flying is the Grob 109A self launching motor glider. This is a comfortable and versatile two seat machine that gives us the option of using it as a pure glider with the engine off, or as a general purpose recreational and touring aircraft with the engine on.

Because we are a small club run by volunteers, we can offer excellent flying rates to our members.

Flying fees are presently: \$80 per hour engine time (flying with the engine on.) + \$30 per hour airframe time (engine off.)

\$110 per hour

In addition, all club members must belong to the Gliding Federation of Australia (GFA), with annual membership of \$246.

There is also an annual club fee of \$150.
